
Te Wnare Ariki o Runga Assenting body of Divine Spiritual law Whakaminenga o Nga Hapu o Nu Tireni





TRESPASS NOTICE

This Trespass notice dated 10 November 2022 replaces all previous trespass notices.

This notice is issued by the Wakaminenga Maori Government pursuant to the paramount jurisdiction of He Wakaputanga 28 October 1835 and Tikanga Customary Laws of Te Rangatiratanga, The Sovereign of Te Wakaminenga o Nga Rangatira me nga hapu, whanau, tangata of Nu Tireni, New Zealand.

Article 2, He Wakaputanga 1835 states: "All sovereign power and authority within the territories of the United Tribes of New Zealand is hereby declared to reside entirely and exclusively in the hereditary chiefs and heads of tribes in their collective capacity, who also declare that they will not permit any legislative authority separate from themselves in their territories, unless by persons appointed by them, and acting under the authority of laws regularly enacted by them in Congress assembled."

As a Sovereign National of Nu Tireni, New Zealand, and member of the Wakaminenga Maori Government, I caution you that all and anyone and including NZ Government agents who enter onto my/our land and premises without lawful authority is in breach of paramount Rangatiratanga sovereign law.

KIA TUPATO WARNING

Anyone found to be unlawfully on my/our whenua, land or private property and dwellings without justifiable reasons are liable to prosecution, penalties, and reparations pursuant to paramount Rangatiratanga sovereign law of Nu Tireni, New Zealand.
